You may count up to 3 one day/ one performance shows towards your total of 8 shows. One “show run” is defined as the “Load In”, all performances and the “Load Out” of one event (play, musical, dance concert, ice show, etc.). This event must include a load in with duties like laundry or costume preparation (ironing, steaming, or repairing costumes); a show call with “time sensitive” cues to be completed during the performance; and a load out with duties like collecting costume or make-up items and loading gondolas, hamper & /or crates for shipping.

You must also perform at least on day work/continuity call on a multiple day/ performance show. This would include shows like the Weidner Center or Fox Cities PAC shows (Phantom of the Opera, Miss Siagon, Etc.) **some** BCA/Resch shows, (Disney on Ice, Sesame Street Live, Etc.) This does not include music concerts at the Brown County Arena, Resch Center or other venues. Doing Laundry & Stitching will only count for 2 shows; the remaining 6 must be met as a dresser.
