#### 2. HAND SEW CLOTHING FASTENERS ONTO FABRIC

- Applicant must sew a shank button, 2-hole button, 4 hole button secure and neat. (3 minutes each)
- Applicant must sew both sides of a snap and a hook and eye combination secure and neat (5 minutes each)

#### 3. DEMONSTRATE THE ABILITY TO MAKE AN EMERGENCY SEAM REPAIR

- Applicant must hand stitch a ripped seam in a silky blouse (4 Minutes)
- Applicant must pin a rip in a Denim Skirt (2 minutes)
- 4. DEMONSTRATE HOW TO DEAL WITH A BROKEN ZIPPER
- 5. ASSIST AN ACTOR IN MAKING A QUICK CHANGE
- 6. IRON SIX UNIDENTIFIED SWATCHES OF FABRIC
